

Let's Understand:

In a sentence written in the <u>active voice</u>, the subject of the sentence performs the action. In a sentence written in the <u>passive voice</u>, the subject receives the action.

We use the **passive** voice when we are more interested in **what** is done than who did/does it.

Eg. Somebody cleans this room every day. (Active)
This room is cleaned every day. (Passive)
