'My Vision for India' is a speech by Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam. He wishes for India to be a developed country. He tells people of their duties. He also inspires them to build a stronger India.

India was attacked and looted by enemies many times. But we have never invaded /attacked any country. This is because we respect the freedom of others.

His first vision is that we must protect our independence. The second vision is to be self-dependent – self-reliant. We must reduce poverty and make economic progress. His third vision is to see India strong, both economically and militarily, because people tend to respect those who are strong.

Dr. Kalam feels that India can become a great nation like America or any country in Europe. This will happen if our people stop criticizing the government and other institutions. A change in attitude is needed. People should stop complaining. They should participate in development by solving problems themselves.
