

Passage Solving

Paragraph Comprehension:

This question is compulsory. It is easy to score marks as you have already practiced it through Reward and Textbook summaries. The questions asked are all factual based and are 'wh' questions. We have given you enough practice from the beginning to answer all the 'wh' questions.

Steps to solve the passages:

- Read the given passage carefully.
- If you come across some difficult words try to guess the meaning by putting them in the context.
- Now read the questions carefully. Look for the keyword in the question and search the same in the passage.
- Copy the selected sentence from the paragraph.
- Preferably write the answers in full sentence.
- Remember to keep the same tense in the answer as is in the question.
 - If there is 'ing' to the verb in the question; keep it in the answer too.
(Present cont. form)
 - If there is 'did' before the verb in the question; make the past tense of the verb in the answer.
- Do not leave any question unanswered.
- If you are not able to frame your own sentence then write the sentence as it is, as the answers
