

Some question samples are given below for practice:

1) You are going to participate in an inter-school elocution competition. The subject given to you is the 'Importance of Sports'. Draft a speech with the help of the points given below:

Points: · Broadening of outlook · Sportsmanship · Inculcation of values · Obedience · Team spirit · Development of leadership qualities · Physical, mental, health · Respect for rivals · Value of time · Self-discipline

2) Prepare a short speech of about 100 words to be delivered by you on 'Environmental Pollution'.

Points: Earth's number one enemy – the reason for air, water and noise pollution – means of plastic – suggest the steps to get of pollutions – add your own points.

3) You have to deliver a speech in the class on 'How to achieve great success'. Prepare a speech with the help of the points given below:
