Using 'Though/Although'

'Though or Although' is used in a sentence to express a contrasting/opposite situation or action.

Simple steps to remember while using 'Though/Although'

- > Though/Although is used to join two sentence as one.
- > We should use *Though/Although* always in the beginning of the first sentence.
- Both the sentences will remain same as it is.
- After using 'Though/Although' in the first sentence, put a comma (,) before writing the second sentence.

Let's take an Example: -

He is very poor.

He is happy.

✓ Though he is very poor, he is happy.

Ravi is working hard.

He will not pass the entrance.

✓ Although Ravi is working hard, he will not pass the entrance.

See... It's very simple...
