

Using 'used to'

'Used to' is used in a sentence to express a past habit/exercise which is no longer happening in the present/now.

Simple steps to remember while using 'used to'

- We should first mark the *Subject and Verb/Helping verb* in the sentence in the sentence.
- We must put 'used to' right in the middle of *Subject and Verb/Helping Verb*.
- After using 'used to' in the sentence, the *Main Verb/Helping Verb* changes it's tense from past to present.
- Apart from the *Main Verb/Helping Verb*, all the remaining part of the sentence remains same.

Let's take an Example: -

Mina went to the dance class twice a week.

- ✓ Subject = Mina Verb = went
- ✓ Mina used to go to the dance class twice a week.
