

1. Write a letter to the editor of a local newspaper giving your views about the increasing use of cell phones by school children. Use of cell phones is leading to distractions and waste of time besides being unsafe. Suggest what schools and parents can do to control this trend.

Your letter should cover the following points:

- Increasing use of cell phones by school children especially in large towns and cities.
- Effects: overuse, unnecessary and prank calls leading to unsafe situations, time wasted- studies affected.
- Steps schools and parents can take: restrict students from carrying them to school.
